Re-entry process begins for the Custer County Junkins Fire Evacuees

RE-ENTRY is authorized for EAGLE SPRINGS RANCH SUBDIVISION and the GREENWOOD SUBDIVISION from CR 390 to mm 24.

- Re-Entry passes must be obtained at the Wetmore Volunteer Fire Station located at 200 County Road 290, Wetmore, CO 81253. Passes are available from 3:00pm to 8:00pm today.
- The re-entry passes are authorized under the authority of the Custer County Sheriff's Office and authorize the person access to his or her property only. Proof of residence and identification are required for a re-entry pass.
- Re-entry to begin at 5:00pm on Thursday, October 20, 2016.
- Evacuation orders remain in effect for the following locations: Highway 96 from MM 20 to 24, County Road 387 and the Smith Creek Sub-Division.
- Custer County Sheriff's deputies will conduct preliminary inspections of all homes prior to re-entry.

PRE-EVACUATION ORDERS have been lifted for all areas of Custer County.

Custer County will be opening a Disaster Assistance Center to provide information and assistance at the Wetmore Volunteer Fire Station located at 200 County Road 290, Wetmore, CO 81253. Hours of Operation: Thursday, October 20, 3:00pm to 8:00pm and Friday, October 2016, 7:00am to 4:00pm.

Highway 96 will be open to thru traffic only from McKENZIE JUNCTION to WETMORE at 3:00 pm today, Thursday, October 20, 2016

No access will be allowed to County Road 387, County Road 395, County Road 358 or the Smith Creek area

Law enforcement will patrol the Greenwood and Smith Creek areas
