The applicant also understands that any falsification of the statement, or any violation of the provisions contained herein or applicable to Custer County regulations, may be punishable by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ten (10) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day during which such illegal erection, construction, reconstruction, alteration or use of any building, structure, or land continues shall be deemed a separate offense. (C.R.S. § 30-28-124). In addition to any penalties imposed pursuant to § 30-28-124, any person, firm or corporation in violation may, by order of the county court, be subject to a civil penalty in an amount of not less than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00). It is within the discretion of the county attorney to pursue the civil penalties set forth in § 30-28-124.5, the remedies set forth in § 30-28-124, or both, which may include injunction, mandamus, abatement, or other appropriate action or proceeding to prevent, enjoin, abate, or remove any unlawful erection, construction, reconstruction, alteration, or use. Each day after the issuance of the order of the county court during which such unlawful activity continues shall be deemed a separate violation and shall be the subject of a continuing penalty in an amount not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each day. In no event shall civil penalties constitute a lien against real property. (C.R.S. § 30-28-124.5) The County shall seek reimbursement for legal fees, costs and such other and further relief as the court deems just, incurred while pursuing legal action against Zoning Resolution violations.

Failure to maintain the sign will result in revocation of the permit.
