MOTION by Commissioner Austin, seconded by Commissioner Custer:

To accept the posted agenda. and add the Upper Arkansas Recycling program contract to the agenda. The motion carried unanimously.

Virginia Trujillo, County Treasurer met with the BOCC and requested a transfer of \$100,000.00 from the Payment in Lieu of Tax (PILT) Fund to the County General Fund.

MOTION by Commissioner Custer, seconded by Commissioner Austin:

To transfer \$100,000.00 from the Payment in Lieu of Tax (PILT) Fund to the County General Fund. The motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Custer presented the participation agreement for the Upper Arkansas Recycling Program for approval and signature. She stated the term of the agreement is from January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010. She stated that Custer County's cost to participate in the recycling program in 2010 will be \$2,566.70 and the amount reflects a \$1,209.80 reduction that was generated by the sale of materials in 2009. Commissioner Custer requested that Custer County appoint her as the Director to the Advisory Board of the Upper Arkansas Recycling Program. The Board agreed.

MOTION by Commissioner Austin seconded by Commissioner Custer:

To approve and sign the Upper Arkansas Recycling Program Contract as presented and designate Commissioner Custer as the Director to the Advisory Board. The motion carried unanimously.

MOTION by Commissioner Austin, seconded by Commissioner Custer:

To adjourn the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.
