DISCUSSION OF EMS SERVICE IN WETMORE

The Board discussed the lack of scheduled EMS coverage in the Wetmore area. Commissioner Printz recommended that there be a workshop scheduled to be able to come up with a comprehensive strategy. The BOCC scheduled an EMS workshop at the Wetmore Community Center on July 17th at 1:30pm.

CONSIDERATION OF PLANNING COMMISSION’S RECOMMENDATION FOR LAND USE POLICIES

The Planning Commission recommends that the BOCC impose a 5-year moratorium on subdivisions countywide to eliminate Special Use Permits (SUP) west of Highway 69; and place a 5-year moratorium on SUP’s east of Highway 69, excluding the municipalities. If approved, the Planning Commission will amend the zoning policy.

MOTION by Commissioner Canda, to accept the recommendation from the Planning Commission of a 5-year moratorium on subdivisions countywide, to eliminate SUP’s west of Highway 69, and to place a 5-year moratorium on SUP’s east of Highway 69, excluding the municipalities, effective July 1, 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

CONSIDERATION OF OEM HIRING PROCESS

The Board discussed the process of hiring a new Office of Emergency Management Director. The interview committee will consist of: the three Commissioners, Christie Coleman (Colorado State DHSEM Regional Field Manager) and Dawna Hobby (HR/Finance Director). The Board also discussed which candidates to interview for the position.

MOTION by Commissioner Flower, to create a hiring committee of Commissioners, Christie Coleman from Colorado State DHSEM, and Dawna Hobby. Motion carried unanimously.
