  - Westcliffe HSAC/ESF5/S. Region Comms Committee August 2<sup>nd</sup>
    - Homeland security grant and other topics
    - Thursday August 2<sup>nd</sup>
    - August 31<sup>st</sup> is the grant deliverable for NIMSCAST (100, 700)
      - PH, EMS, Fire, R&B, EM, POSSE, CERT, etc.
    - Regional Comms. Committee
      - Requested that 1 staff from Custer Central & J. Decker from WMFPD participate

    - BH: Health Care Collation requesting more participation from county agencies

    - BOCC:
      - T. Flower looked at s. hardscrabble creek drainage, another 100 yards and phone line damaged, wrapped around trees and torn into two.
    - EMS:
      - EMT basic class starting August 4<sup>th</sup>, did get the grant for 50%match
- HS Grand Updates, if any
  - No updates from EM
  - 30,000 security fence is still on grant request, October likely for grant contract at the regional level
  - MRC and POSSE haven't spent HS funds yet [grant #17SHS18SR]
  - DTR (radio) grant potential
    - WMFPD Chief Shy proposed finding a single source grant for purchasing new DTR radios
    - Communications need to be the primary focus for HS grants
    - HS funds shrinking; [the entire 2017 South Region grant was a total \$210,492 (of which \$53,400 funds the grant coordinator, travel and cell phone costs)]
    - Recommendation: Agencies should purchase same make/model radios county wide
    - Assessment of communications needs could potentially assist with obtaining grant funds
    - Highly unlikely a single grant source is available. Initial state DTR grants were to build the DTR radio capability; sustaining it is the responsibility of the local agencies

      - Fuels reduction 60,000 project; needs SOW
  - “Office of emergency preparedness and consequence management”

    - Identify Leads, 3-5 deep
  - Reviewed Emergency Management program “day to day” vs. transitioning to Emergency Coordination Center during response
  - Identify Emergency Support Function (ESF) GAPS/ownership
