 - Working on getting the ISO ratings changed, trying to get ratings down to show the insurance rates down.
 - It's all about water issues, there aren't enough water sources around the county.
 - Had a mobile repeater training and working on having it quarterly
 - Will let the CES personnel know when the next training will be
 - Working on fire personnel to have 100/700 and created a policy for each new firefighter to have 100/700 in a certain timeframe.
